Anti-Bullying

Strategies to prevent bullying.

We discussed the strategies we have at Charnwood to prevent bullying. Below is a list of the strategies:

- To have Playground Buddies (Friendship Buddies). These children will check to see that all the children are happy and having other children to play with. If they see any bullying occurring they will tell a member of staff. The playground buddies are all the school councillors.
- Making people aware of what bullying is and what they can do to stop bullying.
 - Anti-bullying posters will be displayed.
 - An Anti-Bullying assembly has been held.
 - Discussion about bullying during P.S.H.E Lessons
- Making rules, which everyone should follow, such as:
 - Be kind to others
 - Keep your hands and feet to yourself
 - Invite different people to play with you
 - Say sorry if you have done something wrong, if you have hurt somebody else.
 - Don't give out our personal details/computer passwords to anyone

We then discussed the new strategies we would like to put into place to prevent bullying:

- Putting up new posters, with the new slogan for this year. This will help inform children what bullying is and how it can be stopped.
- Making children aware of how they can prevent bullying, e.g. teaching them how to say stop, through assemblies, posters and class room discussions.
- The child being bullied and the bully can have some time to play with each other, while an adult is supervising. This will encourage them to become friends.
- Ensure the bully has some time out to reflect on their behaviour.
